From the CEO

We have been working hard to move forward with Vision 2026, our three-year strategic plan. One of our projects focuses on our Intake process. We wanted to make it more streamlined, less confusing, and more transparent and I'm impressed with what the Intake work group has developed. I anticipate a full rollout of the new process later in October. Along with the Intake redesign there is the need to better formulate a private funding mechanism. For families that are waiting for county or Medicaid public funding, ECHO is setting up a private funding path into our services. This too will roll out in October. Also part of Vision 2026 is our decision to combine the LIFE and LIFE+ programs into one day support program. While this decision was not made lightly, neither program has fully recovered from the impact of the pandemic shutdowns and ECHO has concluded that we can no longer offer and support two separate programs. The combined program will have a 1:7 staff to participant ratio, will not include on-site nursing services and will focus on skill-building, maintenance of skills, peer interactions, community integration and enhancement of social networks in a structured setting.

On October 18th our 2nd Annual ECHO Sip and Swing fundraiser at Topgolf takes place. Thank you all who have sponsored this event.
